Dear Mr Campinos,

USF (Union Syndicale Fédérale) congratulates you for your recent election to the Presidency of the EPO, which will take effect from 01.07.2018 onwards. USF is the largest federation of trade unions in the European Public Service, with about 20 branches in European Institutions, agencies and other European Organisations, two of which are at the EPO. USF is an affiliate of EPSU (European Public Service Unions, which is a branch of the European Trade Union Confederation), PSI (Public Services International) and the European Movement.

USF is fully aware of the essential role the protection of Intellectual Property plays within Europe's Internal Market and beyond and also of the new tasks assigned to the EPO through the EU Regulation 1257/2012. The EPO is a major institutional actor and needs to act and be perceived by the public as acting in conformity with the highest rule-of-law standards of the international Public Service.

These highest standards include a genuine social dialogue, the stability of employment as well as trust of the EPO staff in its top management. The unprecedented, seriously worrying reports on the EPO in the European media over the last few years reveal an urgent need for fundamentally revisiting numerous of the current ill-designed and abusive HR policies implemented by the current administration.

USF noted that the EPO Council expressed in its CA Document 26/16 the clear wish that normal social dialogue standards be met at the EPO, so far to no avail. Assuming that you gathered broad support for your election within the representatives of the Member States, USF and the affiliated SUEPO branches are looking forward to substantial improvements especially on social dialogue, rule-of-law and employment stability issues during your mandate.
